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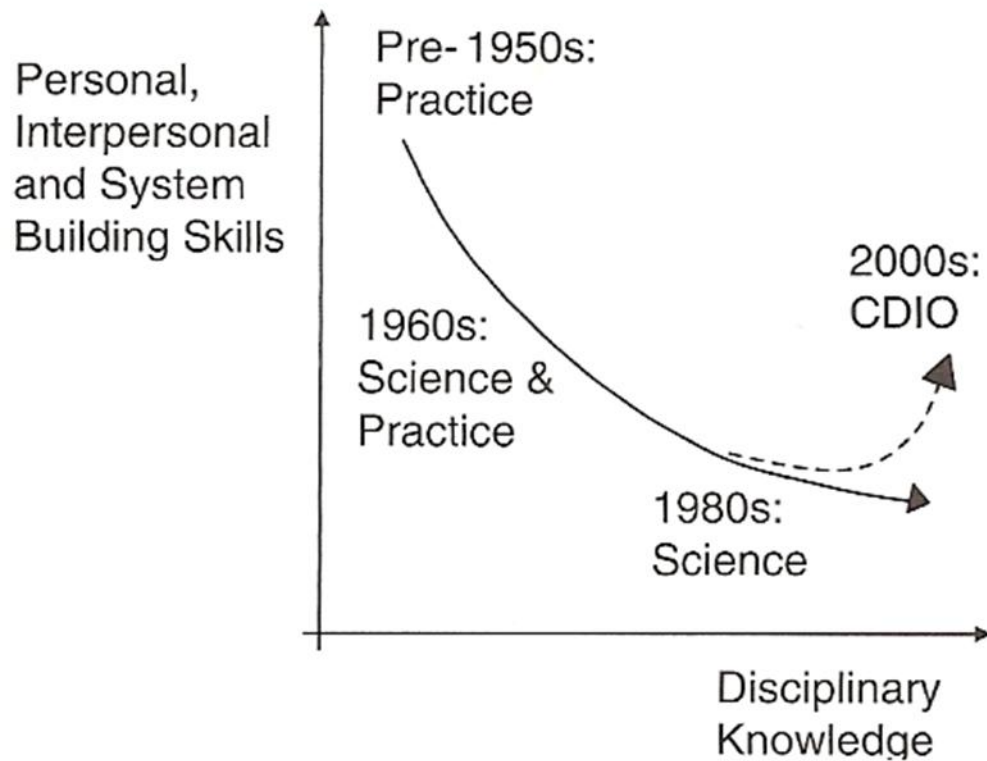
Presentación de Universidad/Institución

 - Technology and Transport (engineering) (7500 students)
 - School of ICT 2750 students
 - School of Industrial engineering 2750
 - School of civil engineering 2000
 - Professors 800

- Locations in 3 cities: Helsinki, Espoo and Vantaa in Finland, 21 addresses

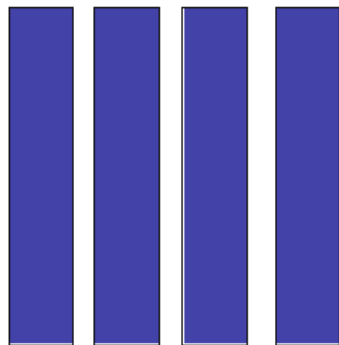
- Bachelor's Degree Programmes conducted in English in the Field of Technology and Transport

- Applied to all engineering programmes

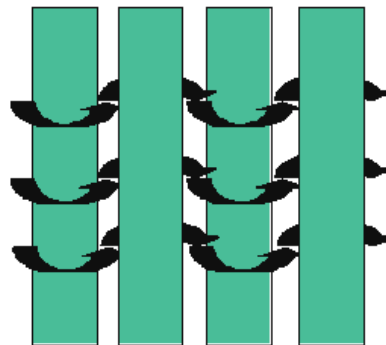
Evolution of Engineering Education



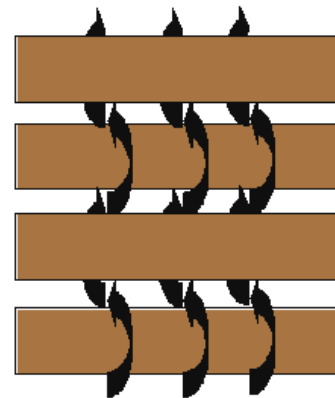
Alternative Curriculum Structures



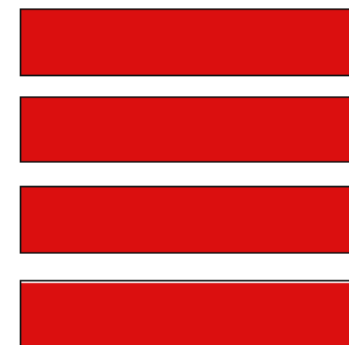
A strict disciplinary curriculum
Organized around disciplines, with no explicit introductions or skills



A CDIO based curriculum
Organized around disciplines, but with skills and projects interwoven



A Problem Based curriculum
Organized around problems, but with disciplines interwoven



An apprenticeship model
Based on projects, with no organized introductions of disciplines
